Chemo and radiotherapy are most of the time still necessary for fighting cancer, but they have side effects which lower our immune system.

Tumour consists of two types of cells, one is stem cells which are growing and can be affected by chemo and radiotherapy. The other is still cells which act as a seed, which can cause cancer to resurface, the chemo or radiation will not be able to destroy them. Therefore chemo or radiation will never cure cancer. However, our immune system (T-Cells) can destroy these seeds. A combination of chemo and radiotherapy and boosting the immune system will increase the rate of successful treatment.
